
Background:

England Netball is the national governing body for netball in the UK. This infographic is a media analysis of coverage of the Netball World Cup in Cape Town, 2023. It collates information from various sources, including viewership from TV coverage on Sky Sports and BBC Sports, social media impressions, website visitor and engagement figures, as well as community netball sessions delivered.

Summary:

Headline statistics shared in the infographic include:

- 3.5 million watched live on Sky Sports and BBC Sport
- 440% increase in visitors to the England Netball Website
- 18 Million social media impressions
- 318 pieces of national media coverage
